NOTICE Pile Painting Job

1. DETAILS OF WORK

Work Structure: Steel Piles, associated fittings (like clamps, beams etc) and pile caps etc.

Total no. of Piles: 251 (Approx) Diameter of a Pile: 1016 mm

Approximate length of each pile for maintenance: Varies from 3.0 m to 17.0 m depending on location. Approx Surface area for painting: 9000 Sq m (+/- 10%) Above job to be completed in Span of two years 2014-15 & 2015-16

We plan to carry out first 4500 Sq m of area during period of Oct, 2014 - May 2015 & another 4500 sq m area during Oct, 2015-May 2016.

The area under present scope of work shall comprise piles of all Trestle piles from Bent no 77 to Bent no 1. Total 251 no of Piles (Total area approx 9000 Sqm), Piles are mainly raked type.

Bidders are requested to quote separately for each as below:

- (i) Offshore Painting job: Bent 77 to Bent 50 will cover 104 Piles of area 5000 Sqm (+/-5%) covered jetty piles which are always over water.
- (ii) Intermediate Painting job: Bent 49 to Bent 29 will cover 79 Piles of area 3000 Sqm (+/-5%) covered jetty piles which are sometimes over water based on tidal height).
- (iii) Land Based Painting job: Bent 28 to Bent 1 will cover 68 Piles of area 1000 Sqm (+/- 5%) covered jetty piles which area always over land)

2. SCOPE OF WORK

2.1. Scope of work for jetty pile painting jobs shall include but not limited to the following

- (i) Complete supply of all painting materials, transportation of men and materials to site, Storage at site, handling, unpacking, disposal of packing material, waste, providing scaffolding, all machinery, all tools & tackles necessary to execute job, cleaning of piles, spot blasting wherever required & sweep blasting on rest of piles, paint application, inspection & testing, retouching (with paint) if required for all items covered in the scope of painting at his own cost except otherwise stated as per engineering standards and technical specifications indicated in the work order herein.
- (ii) The scope of present work herein comprises maintenance painting of Steel Piles and associated fittings upto low water line or other such length based on tide as specified by the Engineer-In-Charge.
- (iii) This work includes provision of skilled manpower including continuous supervision of work by a competent person, designation of site-in-charge, NACE certified inspector for inspection and testing and Project management.
- (iv) All manpower including supervisor and inspector shall have valid experience in offshore painting work.
- (v) All the terms and condition as detailed below will be binding at all times during the contract period failing to abide by the same it shall be at the discretion of Engineer-in-charge to stop the job and/or take necessary action.

2.2. SURFACE AREA TO BE PAINTED

- i) Offshore Painting job: Bent 77 to Bent 50 will cover 104 Piles of area 5000 Sqm (+/-5%) length of pile would be 17 Mtr. to 13 Mtr.
- ii) Intermediate Painting job: Bent 49 to Bent 29 will cover 79 Piles of area 3000 Sgm (+/-5%) length of pile would be 13 Mtr. to 7 Mtr.
- iii) Land Based Painting job: Bent 28 to Bent 1 will cover 68 Piles of area 1000 Sqm (+/- 5%) length of pile would be 7 Mtr. to 3 Mtr.

Minimum Bid Qualification Criteria

Few important and mandatory criteria are mentioned below. The tender document contains complete list of Bid Evaluation Criteria

- a. The bidder should submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for an amount of ₹ 4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Only)) in the form of Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee. The Bank Guarantee should be from a scheduled / Nationalized bank having net worth not less than ₹ 100 crores.
- b. The bidder should have experience of at least one similar work of about ₹ 1.5 Crores (Rupees One Crore Fifty Lakhs only) annualised value during previous 5 to 7 years period. Bidder should submit documentary evidence to this effect in the form of Work Orders and satisfactory completion of certificate(s) of reputed companies.
- c. The turnover of the bidder in similar works shall be ₹ 2.25 Crore (Rupees Two Crore Twenty Five Lakhs only) during any one of last three financial years starting from 2011-12.(The bidder shall submit Last 3 financial year income tax return copy of the company)
- d. The consent/approval/license for providing the services as per the complete scope of work provided herewith from the concerned authority shall be kept valid for the entire duration of the contract and it shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor to maintain/renew the validity of the such consent/approvals there under from time to time, failing which it may lead to cancellation of contract. A declaration to this affect shall be provided on bidder's letter head as per format at Appendix A
- e. The bidder has not been debarred and/or blacklisted by any Central Government / or any State Government Department(s) and the bidder should not have any litigation in any of the labour court(s). An affidavit to that effect on Non-Judicial Stamp paper of ₹ 10/- duly notarized shall be enclosed with the technical bid. An affidavit is to be attached with the tender.
- f. Details of experience and past performance of the bidder on works / jobs done of similar nature in the past and details of current work in hand and other contractual commitments, indicating areas and clients are to be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid, in support of the experience.
- g. The bidder shall quote for complete Scope of Work as & Price schedule. No partial or part quote shall be acceptable, and offer shall stand rejected for partial quoted bid.

Note:- Bidder's representative must visit our site for understanding of the scope of work. Necessary prior intimation to be given to PLL at least 48 hours before scheduled visit.
