Petronet LNG Limited (PLL) signs the binding Transaction Documents with Gopalpur Ports Limited for setting up of LNG Terminal on the east coast of India

PLL has executed binding Transaction Documents viz. (a) Sub-Concession Agreement (b) Sub-Lease deed and (c) Port Service Agreement with M/s Gopalpur Ports Limited on 27.12.2023 for setting up of Floating Storage Regasification Unit (FSRU) based LNG terminal with capacity of ~4 MMTPA (Phase-1), with provision for converting to 5 MMTPA land-based terminal at Gopalpur Port, District - Ganjam, Odisha.

PLL is in process of setting up its maiden LNG terminal on the east coast of India at Gopalpur, District- Ganjam, Odisha which would bring augmentation in overall regasification capacity in the country thereby contributing towards gas-based economy.
