'48% people got medical care before death in 2018'

It's 8.6 Percentage **Points More Than** In 2013: Survey

New Delhi: More people received medical care before death in 2018 as compared to five years ago, the Sample Registration System Statistical Report 2018, released on Friday said.

The data showed there was an increase of about 8.6 percentage points where the deceased had received medical attention before death in hospi-

tals during 2013-2018. In 2018, in nearly 48% deaths, the deceased had received medical attention either at a government hospital or a private hospital. While nearly

50% of them got institutional care, around 20% were attend-

ed by untrained functionaries. In rural areas, more than 23% were attended to by untrained functionaries, whereas


