This clause suggests the baseline should be done to cover minimum 50% of villages and 20% of the population of each village in particular district-As per Census 2011 the no. of villages in the 2 districts of Bharuch (Dahej) and Ernakulum (Kochi) – (50% of total is 358 villages). 20% of the population is a5pprox. 48,000 HH interviews. This will have an impact in terms of the overall cost and time of the project. In our view this sample size is high for any baseline survey. We	PLL does not endorse to Bidder proposal to use statistical tools to get Baseline survey data. However refer to the response by PLL to Query Serial No.4.
